### Aristotelis Papadopoulos

**Agronomist, Soil Water Resources Engineer (MSc, PhD)**



*He was born in Thessaloniki and studied at the Department of Agriculture of the Aristotelian University of Thessaloniki (A.U.TH.). After qualifying exams, on which he came first, he attended the Post Graduate Department of A.U.TH and awarded the MSc degree in Agricultural Hydraulics & Land Reclamations. Then he was granted a four year scholarship by the European Community and submitted his PhD Thesis at the University of Southampton in England.*

*After his National Service, as Infantry Lieutenant of the Greek Army, he was appointed to the Greek Ministry of Agriculture/Institute of Soil Classification and Mapping of Larissa, where he worked in the project of Soil Map of Greece. In 1991 he was appointed as researcher and later, in 2002, as director of the Soil Science Institute of Thessaloniki NAGREF (National Agricultural Research Foundation of the Greek Ministry of Agriculture).*

*His research activities deal with Soil-Water Resources Management and Environmental Engineering. The results of his research efforts have been presented in more than 150 papers published in Greek and foreign referred journals and Conference proceedings and has authored three books. He has taught at the TEI of Thessaloniki and Larissa and served as Visiting Lecturer at the University of Thessaly.*

*He was Director General of Agricultural Research, 2013-2017, in the newly formed Greek Agricultural Organization DEMETER of the Greek Ministry of Rural Development & Food and represented the country on international missions to EU countries, the U.S. and Middle Eastern countries (Israel, Egypt, Morocco).*

*Currently he is the Director of Soil Water Resources Institute (Thermi-Thessaloniki).*
